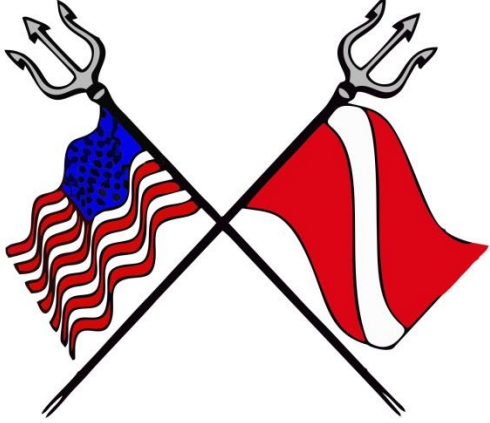

Fishing Contest Rules

1st Annual 1st Ever Underwater/Above water Fishing Contest July 27th 2019

1. Each participant must complete, sign and submit a Disabled Veteran Restoration thru Recreation Scuba contest Official Entry Form. Registration forms are available at www.dvrtrscuba.org. Registration forms, along with the correct entry fee, can be mailed to: Disabled Veterans Restoration thru Recreation Scuba, 701 E State St. Belle Plaine, MN 56011.
2. This event will be held on Huntington Mine, Pennington Mine and Portsmouth Mine, these bodies of water are being fished are Designated Trout Lakes a trout stamp is required to participate.
3. Participants shall be subject to all applicable licensing requirements, as well as any local, state, and federal laws. Licenses are not sold at the event.
4. By purchasing a ticket, and participating in the event, all participants acknowledge and agree that they have reviewed, understand, and will abide by the Rules as posted on our official website. Participants willingly agree to comply with the Rules for participation in the Event.
5. Contest entry fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

6. As a condition of participation in the contest, each participant must execute a Release of Liability. The release indemnifies Disabled Veterans Restoration thru Recreation Scuba and Contest sponsors.
7. Participants must have proper liability insurance for the boat being used in the DVRTRScuba contest.
8. Participants, who are scuba certified, must present certification card upon registering.
9. Scuba equipment will not be available at tournament site for rent; all scuba participants must bring their own gear, to include their fishing **gear**.
10. As a condition of participation in the contest, each participant must sign a Publicity Release Form. This release allows the use of the participant's likeness in all marketing.
11. DVRTRScuba reserves the right to refuse entry to any individuals who have been barred or disqualified from any contest for rules violations.
12. DVRTRScuba officials reserve the right to change, alter, delete or add rules as they see fit.
13. Participants under 18 years of age must have the signature of his/her parent or legal guardian on the entry form, as well as the participant's signature.
14. Any participants engaged in the act of cheating will be turned over to proper authorities.
15. This is a **ROD and REEL** event **ONLY!!**
16. Absolutely no live bait with the exception of worms, wax worms and wax night crawlers.
17. No team fishing is permitted.
18. Only legal game fish will qualify for prizes, **NO ROUGH FISH**.
19. All Participants must be in the weigh-in line at or before 3:05 p.m. on the day of the contest.
20. Contest and raffle prizes are the responsibility of the winners. Licensing, registration, transportation, taxes, and all incidental or consequential expenses incurred are the responsibility of the winners.
21. **No motorized** vehicles are allowed in the contest area unless permitted by the park with a permit in hand.
22. Failure to comply with any contest rules subjects contestants to disqualification and removal from competition site, as determined by contest officials. Right to refuse to sell and/or revoke a competition ticket to anyone is hereby reserved.
23. Contest results remain unofficial until verified by the head judge.
24. Glass containers are not allowed in contest area and will be confiscated by contest officials.
25. Participants are not allowed to enter the fishing contest area prior to 8:00 a.m. on the day of the contest.
26. Participants must enter the contest area through an inspection point. All bags, buckets, bait, containers, etc. must be inspected prior to entering the contest area. Contest officials and

police personnel have the right to inspect any and all items brought through the inspection point, including outerwear.

27. Only fish personally caught by the contestant are eligible to be entered in the contest by that contestant. Fish caught by one individual and given to another person are not eligible. Any contestant who enters a fish caught by another individual will be immediately disqualified.
28. Prizes will be awarded for the three (3) largest fish caught by one individual participant.
29. Contestants are responsible for their own safety, actions and property at all times.
30. No firearms will be allowed in Event Site during Event hours, unless you have an active licensed concealed carry permit or are a credentialed law enforcement officer.
31. All protests or disputes relating to any matter involving the Rules and/or the Event must be registered in writing with the Event Director no later than 3:15 p.m. the day of the Event. Protests made after the deadline will be disregarded. This section does not apply to reporting suspected cheating.
32. Any protest filed by a Participant shall be heard by the Event Director or a delegate of the Event Director. After reviewing the protest submitted, the Event Director shall inform the protesting Participant of the Event Director's decision. The Event Director's decision is final and not subject to further appeal.
33. The interpretation and enforcement of the Rules will be the sole responsibility of the Event Director.
34. The contest ticket and random drawing tickets are two separate items. Random drawing tickets are available and need not be purchased in conjunction with a contest ticket. No refunds will be given for any reason. Random drawing tickets must be purchased with cash only and by an adult over 18 years of age. All Minnesota gambling control regulations are abided by. Random drawing prize winners need not be present to win.
35. Contest prizes must be claimed within 30 days of the contest ending or DVRTRScuba will claim the prize.
36. Event officials reserve the right to refuse entry to anyone in their sole discretion.
37. This is a community and family event, please behave appropriately and respect other anglers.
38. Safe boating conduct must be observed at all times by all participants.
39. Fishing Officially Begins @9:00am.
40. Fishing Officially Ends @3:00pm.
41. Fishing license and trout stamps ARE NOT available for purchase on site, they must be purchased prior to coming to the event.
